

SINCE AND FOR

En el presente perfecto, **since** y **for** se utilizan para especificar la duración de una acción:

- **Since**: Se usa para indicar el inicio de una acción en un momento específico en el pasado.
 - Ejemplo: I have lived here since 2010.
- **For**: Se usa para indicar la duración de una acción, sin especificar el momento exacto en que comenzó.
 - Ejemplo: They have studied English for five years.
